

FRESNO STATE'S DIVERSITY IN STUDY ABROAD GRANT



The Fresno State Study Abroad Grant offers funds to Fresno State undergraduate students of limited financial means to pursue academic studies abroad. Qualified students may receive up to \$10,000 from the Division of Continuing and Global Education towards the cost of eligible study abroad program.

Student Eligibility Requirements:

1. Undergraduate student attending Fresno State
2. Be accepted to a study abroad program for at least four weeks (28 days) in one country
3. Have demonstrated financial aid

Deadlines:

Summer Programs - April 15, 2018
Fall/Academic Year Programs - April 22, 2018
Spring Programs - November 15, 2018

Selection Criteria

Students from diverse backgrounds
First Generation college students
Students with documented financial need
Students going to non-traditional countries, especially those outside Western Europe, Australia, and New Zealand
Academic potential of the program to progress the student towards graduation
